

Frozen Pet Treats

You will need:

- 1 Ice cube tray
- 1 Can of tuna water
- 1 mixing bowl or Magic Bullet
- 1 Ziploc bag

Directions:

1. Start by mashing up the tuna in your bowl or stuffing it into your food mixer. Don't drain the tuna water, it helps with the freezing.
2. Add about half a cup of water to the mix.
3. Then mix up that tuna! I used my Magic Bullet, because really, it's my go-to kitchen appliance and takes 10 seconds. Yum... doesn't that just look delicious? ...
4. Fill your Ziploc bag with the mix and cut a small hole in one end. This helps save you from making a huge mess while filling up the ice cube trays. Fill your trays and place in the freezer for a couple hours.
5. Let pets lick the bowl. When they're nice and frozen, you can pop them out and let your pets have a taste! I recommend letting them chew on these on a tile floor or a plate, because I'm pretty sure you don't want tuna bits all over your house.
6. You can store these in a plastic bag in your freezer for up to 6 months, so if you make a bunch you can always have some on hand!
